

No to YouTube poll video

AN ADELAIDE City Council candidate has been ordered to remove an election campaign video from the internet site YouTube.

Fnuky Advertising agency managing-director David Campbell, 24, was told yesterday by the State Electoral Office yesterday to stop airing the clip because it breached section 27 of the Local Government (Elections) Act 1999.

The Act requires all election material to include an authorisation statement.

He said he would comply but would continue to use the internet in the lead-up to the council's October 19 poll.

"I find it staggering with all the publicity about politicians using YouTube that a candidate running for city council in Adelaide is the first one to be singled out," he said.
