

Websites latest rage

AT LEAST one-in-four candidates have websites.

These include the youngest candidate, **David Campbell**, 24, managing director of Fnucky advertising, and one of the oldest, former Salisbury mayor **David Plumridge**, 75, whose davidplumridge.com is pretty standard of many candidates, giving policy, biography and contact information. Mr Campbell's, at keepadelaidealive.com.au, is one of a few that fields user-generated comments.

Many posted are from friends, or like-minded people. However one respondent wrote the "smart alec . . . intern" should stop "meddling".

Mr Campbell replied: "It's a great city, and has been for a long time, but I want it to become MORE in what it already is, more festivals, food, wine & culture."
